Audio: Please provide Toby with a wireless lapel microphone. On-site sound technicians should test the sound for feedback or blackout spots prior to the event. Toby may move around the entire room during certain parts of his presentation.

Video: Toby's programs feature powerful images as part of live experiments. The quality of the projector, the screen and the reduction of stray light (which may bleed out the screen) are all important for the quality of the audience experience.

Software/internet and other details: Toby will run his presentation from a Mac Pro using ProPresenter custom presentation software. The connection will be via an HDMI cable, please provide an HDMI cable sufficient in length. He will operate the presentation from an iPad Pro. He will bring his own WIFI router to connect both his computer and the iPad. This connection will not utilize an internet connection, but another computer that runs polling software will need an internet connection. For audiences of 100 and more, Toby requests a 30 inch monitor set up on a stand facing the stage (but concealed as much as possible from the audience) with an HDMI cable.

Power needs. The location of the monitor (if needed) will require at least four outlets. A table set up to the side of the stage will require at least 6 outlets (for other computers and sound equipment and optional equipment such as EEG).
